



Partnership Initiation

- Programmatic staff being laying the foundation to ensure smooth start for school and clinician
 - Identifying key relationships within school
 - Ensuring office is set up and kinks are worked out
 - Begin opening enrollment for families



First on site

- Setting the tone
- Introductions and relationship building with key staff
- Strategic presence of clinical staff
- Coaching tips for clinicians



Strengthening Partnerships

- Deepen and build relationships within the schools
- Be proactive about identifying issues, supporting staff, and supporting school
- Understanding and joining the goals of the school
- Support in crisis
- Stakeholder meetings and measurable data



Care Coordination

- With schools
 - Open conversations about expectations and boundaries with families, schools, and our staff
 - Release of information for schools
 - Attending 504s and IEP meetings
- Within CHC
 - Integrated electronic health record
 - Providers can refer and schedule with other providers within the system



Evidence Based Care Strategies

- High importance on evidence based care trainings for clinicians
 - Assessed at initial interview
 - Generous funding for ongoing training
 - Building work groups and supervision for each evidence based practice model
- Stakeholder meetings and Patient Satisfaction Surveys
- Measurement Based Care- MIRAH

- Group therapy
- Utilization of telehealth
