The younger we screen, seal, educate and fluoridate, the better

Pain from oral health disease in children can manifest as:

- anxiety

- •Truancy (Naavaal & Kelekar, 2018)


On average – 34 million school hours are lost annually due to unanticipated/acute dental care (Naavaal & Kelekar, 2018)


Our Services

Preventive oral health care with Registered Dental Hygienists (RDH)

- → Local anesthesia (with a permit)
- → Diagnosis and treatment within scope
- → Radiography
- \rightarrow Oral cancer screenings
- → Interim Therapeutic Restorations (ITR)*
- → Sealant placement
- \rightarrow Silver fluoride application (and other related medicaments)
- → Virtual Dental Homes
- → Limited restorative care with a rotating pediatric dentist


Teledentistry Policy in the US

Teledentistry Scope in Colorado







Our Virtual Dental Home History

- → Started in 2021 at one School-based Health Center SOHP
 - \rightarrow One RDH
 - → One patient navigator
 - \rightarrow One dentist
 - → Program manager oversight
- → Evolution
 - → All five RDH participate
 - → Two patient navigators
 - Participation from the entire pediatric dental residency program residents and faculty
 - → Piloting in the School-based Virtual Health Centers

Formats

- → Synchronous, asynchronous or both
 - \rightarrow Both
 - → Asynchronous + Synchronous
 - → RDH 🖺 🕨 Dentist 🖺 🕨 RDH 🖺 🏗 Patient
 - \rightarrow Synchronous ONLY
 - → RDH Patient
 - → Asynchronous Only (ITR)
 - → RDH Dentist
- → Platform
 - → Epic (Wisdom, Epic Care, Haiku/Canto)



Processes

- → Documentation
 - → All done in patients Electronic Health Record (EHR)
- → Expectation of RDH
 - → IO Photos needed (occlusion, arches, airway, quadrants)
 - → Radiographs needed (modified FMX)
 - → Odontogram documentation (caries)
 - → Follow-up within 10 business days after retuned e-consult
 - → Determine referral route
- → Expectation of Dentists
 - → 72 business hour turn around of asynchronous exams
 - → Details on next visits
 - → Plan treatment on odontogram

Armamentarium


- \rightarrow PC or Laptop that is secure
- \rightarrow EHR Software for secure transmission and information sharing
- → Cheek Retractors
- → Tongue Depressors
- \rightarrow Gauze
- → Digital radiography options
 - \rightarrow (digital sensors or varied sizes OR Optime Phosphorus Plate capturing system)
- → Ortho mirrors
- → Intraoral camera AND other extraoral capturing ability (phone, digital camera)
- → IO Scanner **
- → Blue Check**
- ightarrow Disclosing gel/solution**
- → pH tests * *

Why TeleOralHealth?


- → No follow through by patients
- → Insurance barriers
- → SBHC patients go without a dental exam
- → Denver Health is a Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH)
- \rightarrow Access to care
- → Compliance/Alignment










Asynchronous Case Examples

- \rightarrow 8-year-old patient
- → On schedule for pain and possible abscess
- → Arrived sans pain and no clinical abscesses
- \rightarrow On a 15-minute urgent slot
- → Decided to use time and perform imaging, educate and chart findings









8 y.o. 6 m.o. male presents to SBHC RDH for "intermittent pain and suspected abscess"

ID Confirmed 2x.

CC: Pt not currently in pain today he said "My teeth feel good". Pt presented with new cough and runny nose/congestion since last night.

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


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General Comments:

Virtual SBHC TeleOralHealth Pilot

- → Started in the late 24/25 School-year
- → 30-40 Virtual SBHC sites
 - → Intraoral Camera
 - → Digital otoscope
 - → Pulse oximeter
 - → Remote blood pressure monitoring
- → Nurses can have virtual visit with RDH from my team and use IO camera to help triage a student's dental concern
- → Had 4 visits related to oral health since pilot started



- → Expanded scope for RDH/Dental therapy






