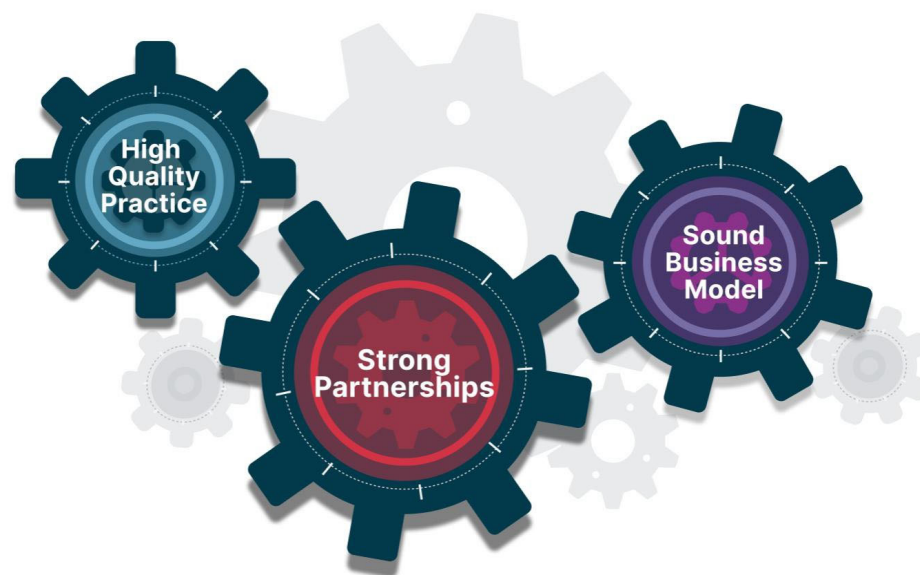

Health sponsor and school partner

- Jointly develop an MOU
- Health sponsor: develop P&Ps for confidentiality; share and discuss them with your school partners
- Meet regularly
- Jointly develop workflows for students to access the SBHC
- Jointly identify opportunities for outreach to students, families, and the community
- Other ideas?

SBHC and partners

- Partner with youth
- Partner with parents
- Partner with other healthcare providers
- Plan and facilitate a planning group or advisory committee (more info to follow)
- Other ideas?



Please share your questions and experiences related to the following practices for strengthening financial sustainability

- Develop a business plan, including financial projections, for the SBHC; ensure the team knows what is needed to “keep the lights on”
- Ensure each SBHC has its own cost center
- Consider sharing a monthly utilization report with SBHC team (health and school)
- Facilitate regular “deeper dive” sustainability updates for the SBHC team (health and school)
- Identify “levers” you can work on to improve sustainability; plan for each partner’s role
